

2010 Arrah Wanna Summer Camp General Information

Welcome to another summer at Camp Arrah Wanna! Please read over ALL the information on this document carefully before registering your camper, taking special note of the early and final registration dates. See you in August!

REGISTRATIONS FOR ALL CAMPS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE LAST DATE LISTED IF QUALIFIED COUNSELORS ARE AVAILABLE!!!

SECTION 1: Dates, Cost & Check-In (Please read Section 3 for instructions on How to Register).

HIGH SCHOOL CAMP - August 1-6th, 2010 (Sunday - Friday)

COST: \$220.00 if registered on or before **July 12th** ~ \$230.00 if registered between **July 13 - July 26th**

CHECK IN: at the Main Lodge between 4:00 & 6:00 P.M. on Sunday, August 1st

CHECK OUT: at the Main Lodge at 10:30 A.M. on Friday, August 6th

MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMP - August 8-13th, 2010 (Sunday - Friday)

COST: \$220.00 if registered on or before **July 19th** ~ \$230.00 if registered between **July 20 - August 2nd**

CHECK IN: at the Main Lodge between 4:00 & 6:00 P.M. on Sunday, August 8th

CHECK OUT: at the Main Lodge at 10:30 A.M. on Friday, August 13th

ELEMENTARY CAMP – August 16-20th, 2010 (Monday – Friday)

COST: \$195.00 if registered on or before **July 26th** ~ \$205.00 if registered between **July 27-August 9th**

CHECK IN: at Main Lodge between 4:00 & 6:00 P.M. on **Monday**, August 16th

CHECK OUT: at Main Lodge at 10:30 A.M. on **Friday**, August 20th

PRIMARY CAMP – August 16-18, 2010 (Monday – Wednesday)

COST: \$100.00 if registered on or before **July 26th** ~ \$110.00 if registered between **July 27-August 9th**

CHECK IN: at Judson Lodge between 4:00 & 6:00 P.M. on **Monday**, August 16th

CHECK OUT: at Judson Lodge 1:00 P.M. on **Wednesday**, August 18th

Primary camp ends with a family barbeque on Wednesday at 12:00 P.M. at Judson Lodge. Cost is \$7.00 per person/\$20.00 max per family (camper's cost is included in the registration) and we ask that you RSVP to the office no later than Friday, **August 13th** so we are sure to have enough food.

PARENTS/DRIVERS: ARRAH WANNA WILL NOT CHECK IN CAMPERS BEFORE 4:00PM ON CHECK-IN DATE. IF YOU ARRIVE EARLY, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO STAY WITH YOUR CAMPER(S) UNTIL CHECK-IN BEGINS. DO NOT LEAVE UNTIL CAMPERS ARE COMPLETELY CHECKED IN WITH A.W. STAFF, AS SUPERVISION IS NOT PROVIDED UNTIL CHECK-IN BEGINS.

Section 2: Bus Transportation

If you or your church are providing your camper's transportation to and/or from Arrah Wanna, please note the check-in and check-out times in Section 1. If you are interested in bus transportation provided by Arrah Wanna, please note the reservation, pick-up and drop-off information below and **RSVP TO THE CAMP OFFICE.**

We provide bus service to and from Arrah Wanna for all camps, **with the exception of Primary Camp**. We are **ONLY** able to offer transportation **TO** Primary camp on **Monday, August 16th**.

Section 3: How to Register

ALL CAMPERS MUST HAVE A SIGNED REGISTRATION/HEALTH FORM ON FILE PRIOR TO CHECK-IN OR THEY WILL NOT BE ABLE TO STAY AT CAMP. COPIES CAN BE DOWNLOADED AND PRINTED FROM WWW.CAMPARRAHWANNA.ORG

1. Complete (1) Registration/Health form for EACH camper.
2. Return the Registration/Health form NO LATER THAN DATE SPECIFIED FOR EACH CAMP TO:

3. In order to ensure that our excellent counseling staff is in place, please make sure that your registration is in the Arrah Wanna office by the specified deadline (6 days before the first day of camp).
4. Make sure that every item is filled in **COMPLETELY** on the Registration/Health form.
5. Please send a \$25.00 deposit with each Registration/Health form.
NOTE: If your church is paying for part/all of the reg. fee, please indicate the amount on reg. form!
6. **PAYMENT OF BALANCE IS DUE AT CHECK-IN**
7. Cancellations made prior to one week before your session are eligible for a full refund (minus the non-refundable deposit). Refunds will NOT be issued for cancellations made less than 1 week prior to your session (illness or injury excluded).
8. **DISCOUNTS AVAILABLE WITH APPROPRIATE PAPERWORK:**
 - a. Early Registration: All registrations received in the Arrah Wanna office by the above-specified dates (3 weeks before the first day of camp) will receive the stated \$10 off registration cost.
 - b. Sibling discount: Send more than one child from your immediate family and each child will receive an additional \$5.00 off.
 - c. Please contact your local ABCO church for scholarship information before contacting Arrah Wanna for any further monetary assistance.

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Section 4: What to Bring & NOT to Bring

1. Sleeping bag / bedding / pillow / PJ's
2. Personal hygiene articles and towels
3. Warm jacket
4. Sturdy shoes for general camp use
5. Flip-flops or sandals for pool area / shower shoes
6. One-piece swimsuit, swim trunks
7. Shorts for warm days / pants for cool nights
8. A good mix of short and long-sleeved shirts
9. Bible, notebook and pen/pencil
10. Flashlight
11. Bug spray
12. Money for the camp store/canteen (no more than \$20)

* Bring shoes or clothing that you do not mind getting dirty, muddy or wet

* All items should be labeled with the campers name and phone number. Arrah Wanna cannot be held responsible for unmarked items that are lost or stolen.

* High School campers are encouraged to bring "funky" dress clothes for a special evening activity.

DO NOT BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS TO CAMP WITH YOU:

1. Two-piece bathing suits; low-cut, midriff-baring, or tube tops; strapless tops or tops w/ spaghetti straps; clothing with inappropriate or suggestive pictures or language on them. Hemlines on shorts, dresses and skirts must be as long as your fingertips when arms are hanging at your side. (Arrah Wanna Executive staff has the final say on ALL clothing-related issues).
2. Items of value: **Cell phones, music players of ANY KIND, video games of ANY KIND**, pagers, etc. If a camper is found using any of the above items, it will be taken away until the end of camp session, even if they claim they are talking to their parents. It is important to be engaged in the program while here at camp at all times. **PARENTS: PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF THIS AND CALL THE CAMP OFFICE IF YOU NEED TO CONTACT YOUR CAMPER!!!**
3. Illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia of any kind; alcohol of any kind; tobacco of any kind.
4. Weapons of any kind, including POCKET KNIVES.

IF ANY OF THE OBJECTS FROM ITEM 1 & 2 ABOVE COME TO CAMP, THEY WILL BE COLLECTED BY THE CABIN COUNSELOR AND TURNED INTO THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR FOR THE ENTIRE CAMP SESSION. IT WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CAMPER TO RETRIEVE HIS OR HER ITEMS FROM THE PROGRAM DIRECTOR BEFORE DEPARTING CAMP AT THE END OF THE SESSION.

IF ANY OBJECTS LISTED IN ITEM 3 & 4 ABOVE COME TO CAMP WITH A CAMPER, ARRAH WANNA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEND THAT CAMPER HOME IMMEDIATELY!

Section 5: Health Information

ALL CAMPERS MUST HAVE A SIGNED REGISTRATION/HEALTH FORM ON FILE AT CHECK-IN OR THEY WILL NOT BE ABLE TO STAY AT CAMP. COPIES CAN BE DOWNLOADED AND PRINTED FROM WWW.CAMPARRAHWANNA.ORG

A trained/certified medical staff and nearby clinic assure that you are well taken care of while at Arrah Wanna. If there are any changes / additions to your medical form, please contact the camp office prior to your arrival at camp. ALL medication (prescription & OTC) must be given to the medical staff upon check-in. **Prescription medicine must be in the original container with the original labeling.** Your insurance is primary and Arrah Wanna's insurance is secondary. Unless prescribed by a doctor, please do not send your child with fluoride, as it creates more work for the medical staff than necessary. Thank you!

Mail-call is one of the best parts of the day for a camper who actually gets mail! If you would like to send your camper a letter, please send it no later than (2) days before the first day of camp to ensure that it arrives on time (Friday before camp is always a sure bet). Letters can be sent to:
