A lifeguard is required for all waterfront activities—fishing, tubing, and swimming. Groups are welcome to bring their own Red Cross certified lifeguard, or an Arrah Wanna lifeguard can be hired, for a nominal fee, with 30 days advance notice. Off-site recreation and activity opportunities abound in the Mt. Hood area—Timberline, Ski Bowl, Maupin, Mt. Hood Meadows, and numerous lakes for canoeing and picnicking! Make one of your meals a sack lunch and head to the mountain for the day! There is also a world-class golf course less than five minutes away from our front door., as well as a library, bookstore, unique gift shops, and an internet café (wireless internet service is available in certain areas of camp).
